JOB SUMMARY

This is an exciting opportunity to work on cutting-edge clean energy topics as part of a collaborative international team of energy transition experts. The junior associate will support RAP's work to accelerate the decarbonisation of energy production and demand in Europe. Key priorities for our work in Europe are affordable electrification of energy demand in transport, buildings, and industry; increasing deployment of renewable energy sources; ensuring energy market regulation and grid management is aligned with a net-zero future; and promoting equitable solutions and those that alleviate energy poverty.

Depending on your interest and profile you could support work across a range of ongoing projects. For example, providing in-depth qualitative and/or quantitative analysis supporting RAP to deliver policy and technical assistance to governmental and industry decision-makers on heat decarbonisation, reducing electricity grid congestion, or combining social and climate objectives across a range of transition policies.

The junior associate will join a talented team based across Europe and have opportunities for further professional growth within our Europe programme work. RAP offers substantial flexibility in topics taken on and the degree of responsibility assumed depending on preference and experience of the applicant. ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Study, monitor and analyse governance, policy, and regulatory developments in areas relevant to RAP's work. These areas include renewable and energy efficiency policy; energy markets, pricing, and taxation; EU and national support policies; grid management; decarbonisation of heating and cooling.
- Research case-studies and best-practices globally and in Europe.
- Support the project team in writing original policy and technical briefs, undertake critical analysis, prepare reports, and present findings. Depending on preference and skills of the applicant the work could be oriented towards qualitative and/or quantitative analysis.

- Support the development of policy recommendations for both EU and national policy.
- Engage in outreach activities. This may include organising or participating in conferences and workshops for high-level decision-makers, making/giving presentations, writing blogs and opinion pieces, networking and identifying opportunities for engagement with relevant stakeholders.
